**Partners HealthCare, Massachusetts General Hospital Earn 'Top Places To Work'  
Honors From *The Boston Globe***

BOSTON, MA – Partners HealthCare and Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) have been named two of the Top Places to Work in Massachusetts in a new employee-based survey from *The Boston Globe*. The Globe 100's Top Places to Work magazine was published in the *Boston Sunday Globe* on November 9.

The Top Places to Work recognizes the most progressive companies in the state based on employee opinions about company leadership, compensation and training, diversity/inclusion, career development, family-friendly flexibility, and values and ethics. Private companies and nonprofits as well as publicly-held businesses were included in the analysis.

The rankings in the Globe 100's Top Places to Work are based on survey information collected by Workplace Dynamics, an independent company specializing in employee engagement and retention, from 70,000 employees at some 300 Massachusetts organizations. This marks the first time that a Globe 100 report honors private as well as publicly-held organizations.

The publisher of *The Boston Globe* **Steve Ainsley** stated, "All the companies included in the Globe 100's Top Places to Work deserve a great deal of recognition. It's clear that they value their employees and make it a priority to create a positive workplace."

The 'Top Places' recognition comes on the heels of other recent honors for Partners. Earlier in 2008, MGH and Brigham and Women's Hospital, the founders of Partners HealthCare, ranked among the top ten in the *U.S. News & World Report* annual Honor Roll of America's Best

Hospitals. Also in 2008, Partners was recognized as one of the area's largest corporate charitable contributors by the *Boston Business Journal* and honored by Project Bread as Corporate Citizen of the Year. Partners was named one of the top 100 places to work in IT by Computerworld Magazine, while Partners President & CEO James J. Mongan, MD received Modern Healthcare's IT Achievement Award for 2008.
