

Recruitment Fraud Alert

We have been advised that there have been instances of attempted recruitment fraud where scammers purporting to be from Partners HealthCare System or a Partners HealthCare System affiliate have made fraudulent offers of employment to job seekers. These fraudulent offers may include a request that the applicant provide sensitive personal or financial information or engage in fraudulent financial transactions as part of the application process.

Please be aware that if you are applying for a job with Partners HealthCare or an Affiliate of Partners HealthCare, Partners has a formal application process which requires the completion of an online application on our Job Search page within our Partners HealthCare Careers website. Partners does not make offers of employment without at least one formal in person interview with a Partners representative.

Partners will not request an interview via text message, instant messaging services or Google Hangout. Partners will never request or require the payment of money for the opportunity to work at Partners and does not require or request bank account or credit card information as part of the application process.

If you think that you may have provided personal information in connection with a fraudulent posting, we encourage you to take the following actions:

- File a report with your local law enforcement authority.
- Contact the three major credit-reporting bureaus (Equifax, Experian, and Transunion) and request that a Fraud Alert be placed on your account.
